REMEMBERING ONE OF OUR CLIENTS...

The below story was sent to us from Sandy Brown, Alexandria Senior Center Director.

"We lost (name redacted) this week. Feisty and eccentric, she was a regular participant until the last two years. She fought kidney failure and survived on dialysis three times each week for the last five-plus years (truly a miracle!).

"If it weren't for our UCARTS service (transportation tickets), her trips to Lebanon for treatment would have been impossible. Our meal program made a huge difference to her life as she was very poor, living in the nearby projects and surviving on food stamps and TennCare. She had a little dog she adored; she sacrificed frequently to care for him. I know I'll miss her calls!"

UCHRA POLICY COUNCIL APPROVES RESOLUTION ASKING REWRITE OF PORTIONS OF LEGISLATION AIMED AT DISSOLVING THE AGENCY'S COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PROGRAM



The UCHRA Policy Council has approved a resolution asking to rewrite portions of legislation aimed at dissolving the Community Corrections program.

"We're very concerned about that," Farley said. "Obviously, we hate to lose that as a program. We think it is very beneficial. We serve a target population there and are able to keep them out of incarceration. We think that is a very valuable service to our citizens."

Established in 1985, the Community Corrections provides alternatives to incarceration for non-violent felony offenders.
