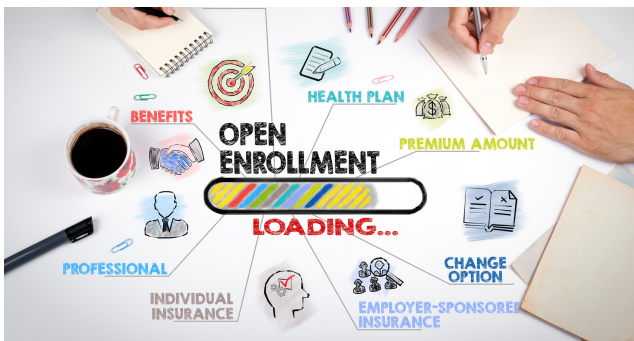


## UCHRA PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION OFFERING FREE RIDES TO BLUES AND BREWS TICKET HOLDERS
