HOW DOES THE SENIOR COMMUNITY SERVICE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM WORK?

The Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) was established under Title V of the Older Americans Act and is funded through a grant from the Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration.

SCSEP provides income-eligible unemployed individuals age 55 and over with paid part-time job training positions within organizations or host agencies, like Upper Cumberland Human Resource Agency, that serve community needs. While in the program, participants receive work-relat-

ed training to gain the skills and experience they need to transition into unsubsidized employment.
