
RTAP TO RECOGNIZE UC DRIVERS AS FRONTLINE HEROES

The Drivers in the 14 Counties of the Upper Cumberland will be officially recognized as Frontline Heroes.


The Rural Mobility Champion Award is being presented to the 120 Public Transportation drivers across the Upper Cumberland by Holly Montooth.
