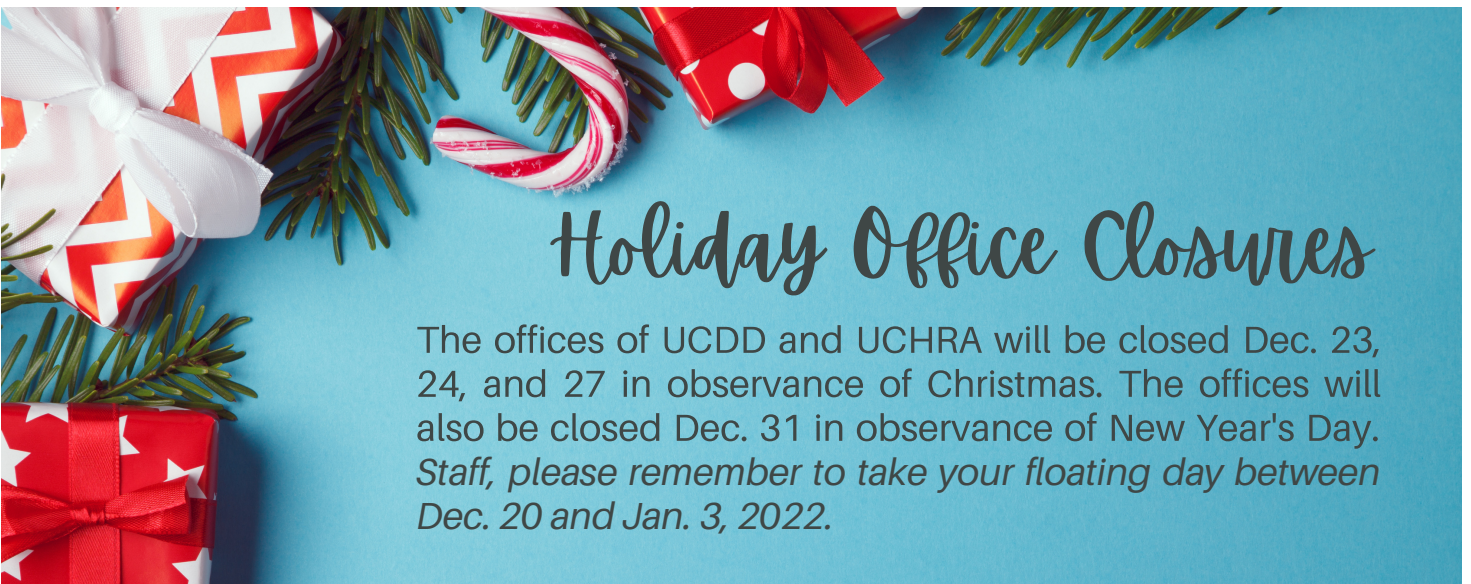
RTAP TO RECOGNIZE UC DRIVERS AS FRONTLINE HEROES
