## UCHRA RECEIVES FUNDS TO HELP INELIGIBLE CLIENTS WITH UTILITY BILLS

Last month, UCHRA received a generous donation totaling \$50,000 from the Caney Fork Electric Cooperative, Tennessee Valley Authority, and Co-Bank. These funds will help eligible CFEC members, who are above the income guidelines for LIHEAP, with one month's electric bill. LIHEAP eligibility is based on established federal poverty guidelines.


