The resolution approves the UCHRA Public Transportation Department to apply for a Driver Training Matching Grant Program through Public Entity partners; and authorizes UCHRA to provide matching funds to serve as a match for any monies provided by the grant.		
DISCUSSION	Executive Director Mark Farley presented Resolution 22-10-2 for approval. The resolution approves the UCHRA Public Transportation Department to submit a grant application for a new Warren County Hub of Operations through the TDOT IMPROVE Act Grant Program; and authorizes UCHRA to provide a 20% matching sum to serve as a match for any monies provided by the grant. The maximum total award amount shall be no greater than \$875,000, which at most would required \$175,000 of local matching funds.
