EMPOWER UC FUNDRAISING LUNCHEON A SUCCESS

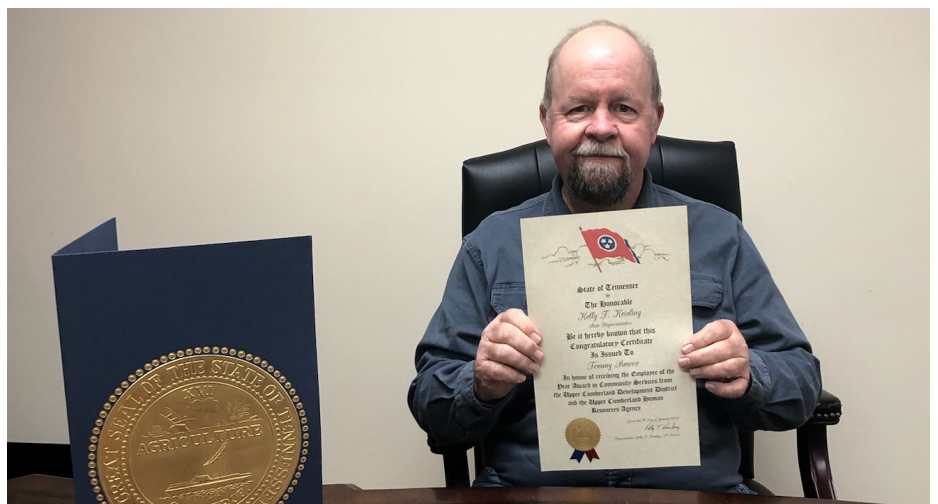

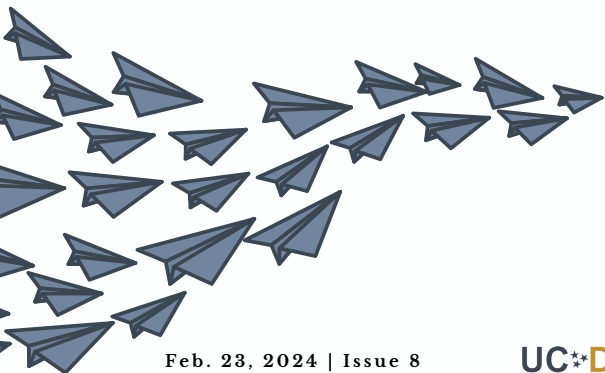
My Bag My Story is a nonprofit organization in Nashville focused on improving the lives of children in foster care by elevating their sense of dignity and self-worth.
