UCHRA TEAM PERFORMS OUTREACH AT HAVEN HOUSE



Recently, Carrie Baker, UCHRA Warren County Coordinator, went to Haven House to inform individuals about services provided by UCHRA. In addition, Kenneth Roberts came by on a Go Route bus to answer questions that clients might have about riding McMinnville's city loop route and Ride to Recovery team members also provided backpacks packed with supplies for the homeless. The UCHRA team also served chicken noodle soup and desserts. Haven House, located in McMinnville, is a shelter for women and children.

CREATING CARE BAGS FOR THOSE IN NEED

In a joint venture with UCHRA Public Transportation's Ride to Recovery Program and UC Recovery, more than 400 care bags are currently being assembled. These bags contain, a Meal Ready to Eat (MRE), blanket, hand warmers, hygiene kits, Narcan kits, and resource materials from a multitude of local and regional partners.

These bags will be dispersed throughout the region in an attempt to help those struggling with addiction and/or homelessness. So far, more than 30 bags have been given away.

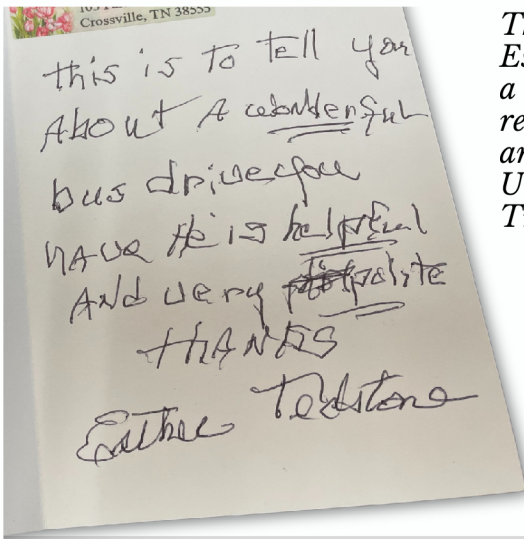
