UCHRA GEARS UP FOR STATE ROADEO COMPETITION




Next week, UCHRA Public Transportation mechanics and drivers will take center stage at the Tennessee Public Transportation Association (TPTA) State Roadeo Competition!

OPEN ENROLLMENT: ACT NOW TO SECURE YOUR BENEFITS

Open Enrollment for medical, vision, dental, and supplemental benefits is underway and runs through Oct. 31. This is your annual opportunity to review and adjust your coverage for the upcoming 2026 plan year. Whether you're enrolling for the first time, adding or removing dependents, changing plan options, or opting out, now is the time to make those decisions.

Why Timely Enrollment Matters

In Tennessee, approximately 9.3 percent of residents remain uninsured, equating to around 654,000 individuals without health coverage in 2023. This rate has remained steady, highlighting the ongoing need for accessible and affordable healthcare options, according to *The Sycamore Institute*.

Additionally, *Healthcare Value Hub* states 61 percent of Tennessee adults reported experiencing healthcare affordability burdens in the past year, with many delaying or forgoing necessary care due to cost concerns.

What You Need to Know for 2026

• Delta Dental is transitioning to MetLife: Even if your dental coverage automatically rolls over, you must submit your enrollment form with "NO CHANGES" noted to ensure continued coverage.

• Updated Premium Rates: All plans have new contribution rates that will apply to your paycheck starting Jan. 1, 2026.

 Health Savings (CDHP) Plan Participants: If you're enrolled in this plan, confirm that you've received provider change information. Contact HR if you have not.

To complete your enrollment, fill out the applicable parts of the form, attach any required documents, sign, and submit your completed form to hr@ucdd.org by Oct. 29.

Forms received after this date may not be processed during the Open Enrollment period.

HOSTING AN EVENT AT UCDD? HERE'S WHAT TO KNOW

As UCDD continues to welcome community partners and guests into our offices, we want to make sure every visit is a positive one—for them and for us!

Creating a welcoming, professional environment takes teamwork, and we appreciate everyone's help in following (and sharing) a few important reminders.

If you're hosting an event or working with a partner organization that plans to use our conference space, please take a moment to go over these guidelines with them ahead of time. A quick conversation can make all the difference in keeping things on track and running smoothly.

All audiovisual (AV) presentations should be emailed to <u>connect@ucdd.org</u> at least 24 hours before the event. This gives our team time to upload materials and make sure everything works properly. To keep our network secure, please remember that outside equipment can't be used, and any flash drives must be submitted to IT for approval at least 24 hours in advance.

Because our office opens at 8 a.m., guests won't be able to enter before that time.

If an event is scheduled to begin right at 8, please let attendees know that early access can't be guaranteed. When possible, we recommend starting events at 8:30 a.m. or later to allow a little extra breathing room for setup and arrivals.

Guests should stay within designated areas (the conference room(s), restrooms, and kitchen), and signs will be posted as a reminder. We also ask that everyone be mindful of noise in shared areas such as hallways, smaller meeting spaces, and the kitchen, which remains open for staff use during breaks and lunch.

As a friendly reminder, smoking, vaping, or similar activities aren't permitted near entrances or in front of the building. And if an event changes, whether it's canceled, rescheduled, or shortened, please let us know right away so we can update the booking calendar.
